Texell Credit Union Breaks Ground on New Headquarters

Temple, TX (Sept. 15, 2022) – Texell Credit Union held a groundbreaking ceremony at the location of the credit union’s new headquarters on Sept. 7, 2022, at 9:30 a.m. About 60 were in attendance, and remarks were made by Mike Haddon of the architecture firm Haddon Cowan; Rod Henry, President and CEO of the Temple Chamber; and Adrian Cannady, President and CEO of the Temple Economic Development Corporation. Tim Davis, Temple’s Mayor, and State Rep. Hugh Shine also gave inspiring remarks.

“Living in Temple, Texas, is one of the most inspiring places to live when you look at the development that goes on,” said State Rep. Hugh Shine. Shine presented Tony Hale, Texell’s President and CEO, with a leadership challenge coin designed by Shine. “Thank you for making Temple your choice for your headquarters,” Shine continued. “And thank you for making our community a better community.”

Located in Temple near our current West Adams branch, the more than 45,000-square-foot building will have the capacity for 176 employees and is expected to be completed in 2024. In addition to office space, the headquarters will feature an employee fitness center, dining area, and several multipurpose rooms.
